### **Camp Registration and Information Form**

This year our annual Seidokan Aikido Camp will be held once again, in Kalamazoo, Michigan on the campus of Western Michigan University. (This was the site of camp in 1994, 1997 and 2003. However, we will be in different dorms this year.)

Camp this year will be starting on Thursday evening so we can have an additional day of training. Through a special arrangement camp fees cover Fri, Sat, & Sun... essentially Thursday is a free day. This means those of you attending the full camp will be getting an extra day for free. It also means that, **NO**; if you are not able to arrive till Friday there can be no refund or reduced fees as essentially there is no charge for Thursday night to begin with. We are very pleased to be offering what I'm sure will be a great camp experience at a very, very reasonable rate.

#### **Dates:**

Thursday, June 19<sup>th</sup> till Sunday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Check in will start on Thursday at 3 pm and check out will end on Sunday at 2 pm. (A complete camp agenda will be e-mailed to you after registration.)

#### **Camp facilities:**

Rooms are suites (2 bedrooms per suite, 1 bed in each room). Each floor shares a communal bathroom. Included will be bed sheets, pillow and pillowcase, 2 towels and 1 washcloth. (No blanket - if you want one, bring it.) There will be 1 meal on Thursday night, 3 meals on Friday and Saturday and 2 meals on Sunday. (Food is cafeteria style and there are lots of places for food delivery or pick up for late night munching.)

#### **Camp Banquet:**

As in the past, will we be trying to make this a very enjoyable social event as well as training event. On Friday evening we will host a catered camp banquet from 7 or 8 till 10. Included will be a vegetarian dish such as vegetable lasagna (which everyone really liked last time we were at WMU), along with other food choices. As in the past, we are arranging for martial arts demonstrations during our feast... you may want to bring a camera.

#### **Special Note:**

There will be a cash bar at our banquet this year - yes, alcohol.

**Fees:**

**Shodo O Seisu Rate:** payment (or a non-refundable down payment of \$50 - balance to be paid by June 1<sup>st</sup>) from now till March 31<sup>st</sup>: Seidokan Members - \$250. Non-members - \$275.

**Masa Katsu Agatsu Rate:** payment (or a non-refundable down payment of \$50 - balance to be paid by June 1<sup>st</sup>) from April 1<sup>st</sup> till May 31<sup>st</sup>: Seidokan Members - \$275. Non-members - \$300.

**Satsugen Ken Rate:** payment (in full) received after June 1<sup>st</sup>. Seidokan Members - \$300. Non-members - \$325.

For those with friends and/or family in the area. You may purchase tickets for just the banquet at \$25 each. All extra tickets must be purchased prior to June 10<sup>th</sup>.

If you are driving to the campus you will need a parking permit. Those will be available at the check-in desk at a cost of approximately \$15 for the entire duration of camp.
